SECONDARY & MIDDLE SCHOOLS

APPEAL STAGE	DATE
National Offer Day applications (those received on time)	Friday 1 March
Deadline for first round secondary/middle school appeals (must give applicant 20 school days from date of refusal to prepare and lodge their appeal ¹)	Monday 30 March
Appeals will be heard (Must be heard within 40 school days of the deadline to lodge appeal ²)	Between Monday 11 May and Thursday 18 June
LATER APPLICATIONS WILL BE HEARD AS FOLLOWS:	Applicants must be given 20 school days to return and lodge their appeal. Within 40 school days of that date, their appeal will be heard.

INFANT, PRIMARY & COMBINED SCHOOLS

APPEAL STAGE	DATE
Primary National Offer Day applications (those received on time)	Monday 20 April
Deadline for first round infant/primary/combined appeals (must give applicant 20 school days from date of refusal to prepare and lodge their appeal)	Monday 19 May
Appeals will be heard (Must be heard within 40 school days of the deadline to lodge appeal ³)	Between Thursday 18 June and Friday 24 July
LATER APPLICATIONS WILL BE HEARD AS FOLLOWS:	Applicants must be given 20 school days to return and lodge their appeal. Within 40 of that date, their appeal will be heard.

Applications for in-year admissions⁴, parents must be given 20 school days from the date of refusal to prepare and lodge their appeal. The appeal must be heard within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged.

⁴ An application is an 'in-year' application if it is for the admission of a child to a relevant age group and it is submitted on or after the first day of the first school term of the admission year, or it is for the admission of a child to an age group other than a relevant age group.

Please note that some schools may have specific dates reserved for appeals. This should be displayed on their website. Local Authorities will have second, third and even fourth admission rounds, all will be treated as late applications, however appeals will be heard within the required timeframe.
